 Examined & Oath and State of Virginia my lawful Attorney in fact with full power and authority to  
 to C.R. Gray Esq. Clerk, State, adjust and bring or prosecute all claims and demands, Laws or otherwise  
 for my Master entituled to me and to any Lands, or rents therefor in the County of Southamptons  
 October 9<sup>th</sup> 1833 before or any other County in Law or Equity as the representative of Patsy Kirby  
 Richard Clarke et al. and Samuel Bedford et al. also the two former late of the  
 State of Virginia and the latter the District of Columbia, and recover and sue the  
 same in such manner as he shall think proper, and Conveyances thereto made  
 in such manner, as he shall think most expedient for my interest and advantage.  
 Wishes to receive and acquiesce to give for me and in my name in all cases necessary  
 and to bring any suit or suits in law or Equity for me and in my name for obtaining  
 any of the aforesaid estates or proceeds thereof, and with full power to defend any suit  
 or suits that may be brought against me concerning the premises above mentioned  
 all and every other act or thing that I could lawfully do in and concerning the premises  
 if I was personally present hereby ratifying and Confirming all such acts and things  
 that he my Said Attorney shall lawfully do concerning the premises. In Testi-
