*Book* This Indenture made and entered into this 19<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year of our Lord 1832, by and between Weston Pope and Sally Pope his wife of the one part John Beck of the other part and of the County of Southampton with respect that for and in consideration of a debt owing of Ten acres of land in a certain tract Lot or parcel of Land sold by the said Sally Pope while the widow and relict of John Beck deceased to the above named John Beck they the said Weston Pope and his wife have for and in consideration of said debt covenanted sold and lawfully grant bargain and sell unto the above named John Beck the like quantity of Ten acres of Land lying and adjoining the Land sold as aforesaid by the said Sally Pope them the saids to have the said John Beck which Land lyeth in the County of Southampton the term days of which are as follows to wit Beginning at two small red oaks standing in a line as well for said James as the above named Pope's thence nearly a direct course to a pine stump a corner in said James' line to James Morrell's line to a pine a corner thence along said Morrell's line down a drain or branch nearly north by East to a black gum, <sup>a corner</sup> as by running a straight line from said drain or branch to the two red oaks named beginning as shall make the full quantity of ten acres of Land which ten acres of Land they the said Weston Pope and Sally his wife do hereby convey all right title interest and estate which they have heretofore held in and to the same to him the said John Beck his heirs and assigns forever free from the claims of them the said Weston Pope and Sally his wife and their heirs and also free from the claim or demand of any and every person or persons whomsoever the right and title of which the above described Land they do by these presents warrant and will forever defend unto him the said John Beck his heirs and assigns forever.
