Wellons of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia seller of the first part Richard Kelle Trustee of the second part and James B. Wellons Creditor of the third part Whereas the said James B. Wellons being party of the first part to the said James B. Wellons in the past and full sum of two thousand and twenty five dollars of lawful money of Virginia for and in consideration of which debt the said James B. Wellons is desirous of securing. Now this Indenture Witnesseth for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar in hand paid unto the said James B. Wellons by the said Richard Kelle at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the title whereof is hereby acknowledged that the said James B. Wellons do give grant bargain and release and confirm to the said Richard Kelle Trustee his heirs and assigns all the following property to wit, say one horse and saddle my stock of hogs sheep cattle &c. two glazier beds and furniture one barrel and its contents one desk two tables six Mahogany chairs Eight frames chairs one chest together with all and every part and parcel of my household and kitchen furniture my crop of corn fodder peas potatoes &c. &c. with all my interest in demands or demands from my estate whatsover may I own just or due me my heirs Executors or assigns belonging to the said James B. Wellons. To have and to hold the aforesaid property hereby conveyed unto said Richard Kelle his heirs from assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Richard Kelle his heirs and said James B. Wellons for himself his heirs from assigns &c. do hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said Richard Kelle his heirs from assigns that the said Richard Kelle his heirs from assigns shall and lawfully may and forever defend against all person or persons claiming the aforesaid property hereby conveyed upon Trust Notwithstanding that the said Richard Kelle his heirs and assigns shall permit the said James B. Wellons to remain in quiet possession of the aforesaid property hereby conveyed and take the profits thereof to ten years and until default be made in the payment of the said two hundred and twenty five dollars either in whole or in part. and then upon this further Trust that the said Richard Kelle Trustee as aforesaid his heirs from assigns shall and lawfully may and forever defend after the happening of such default of payment as he may think proper the said James B. Wellons his heirs from assigns shall request since the aforesaid property with profits arising from the same which is hereby conveyed or sold
