James To Herrel This Indenture made this 23rd day of October in the year one of our said one thousand eight hundred and thirty two Between James Jones of the County of Southampton of the one part and Anthony M. Howell of the County of aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said James Jones for and in consideration of the full and lawful sum of two hundred dollars current money of Virginia to be paid by the said Anthony M. Howell to them or their heirs paid and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said James Jones doth hereby acknowledge and their respective and due charges the said Anthony M. Howell has been and a proper forever and themselves themselves fully and entirely satisfied and paid their granted bargain sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and release with our consent and confirm unto him the said Anthony M. Howell and to his heirs and assigns forever all that plantation meadow tract and parcel of land whereunto the said James Jones now lives it being the tract of land of the Parish of Drake situated being and lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid and containing by estimation seventy five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a common tree a corner post made there bound by a line of marked trees to a corner tree of said land and in the Parish which is a post set down up the branch to about seven o'clock a line of marked trees a pine corner of Joshua Jones's line thence along a line of marked trees to a pine corner of Drake thence along said line to the oak corner of the Parish of Drake thence bounded by said line to a pine corner of said land and then a straight line to the beginning with all houses out houses edifices buildings &c. &c. ways waters
