

on each two four tables for head of Cards eight or Ten 1 hour and a half, one Squarrell gun  
 two bows and arrow 3 narrow axes 3 plow hoes and 2 Cutters &c To have and to hold  
 the said property or moneys as aforesaid and all the right title and interest and estate what-  
 ever of him the said Richard C Gray of us and to the same to him the said John R.  
 Bryant his heirs & assigns or next to the only proper use and behoof of him the said  
 John R Bryant forever. In Trust nevertheless that of the said Richard C Gray his heirs  
 executors or assigns shall and may pay the said James R Bryant the aforesaid sum above mentioned  
 with interest which shall have accrued thereon or before the time the said James R Bryant  
 may or shall require the same the interest and every thing therein contained is to be paid  
 and of same effect. But if the said Richard C Gray his heirs & assigns shall or do not pay the said sum  
 of twenty nine dollars and thirty six cents within named with interest which shall have accrued  
 theron or before the payment of the aforesaid sum shall be demanded as aforesaid thereupon the  
 request written either of the said James R Bryant his heirs & assigns or of the said Richard C Gray his  
 heirs & assigns shall and may sell and dispose of the aforesaid property named as aforesaid or such a  
 part thereof as may be required for the payment of the aforesaid sum of money and interest at pub-  
 lic auction for ready money in the said County giving at least ten days previous public  
 notice of the time and place of such sale by advertisement posted up in at least three public  
 places in the said County and that the proceeds of such sale after paying and satisfying all  
 costs attending the execution of this Trust applied by the said John R Bryant to the discharge  
 of the aforesaid sum due and owing to the said James R Bryant as aforesaid or demands  
 thereof as may be required or be due together with interest which shall have accrued thereon  
 and surplus of money thereafter arising or remaining in the hands of the said John R Bryant  
 is to be paid over by the said John R Bryant to the said Richard C Gray in case the said  
 the said John R Bryant shall die before the execution of this Trust his executors or administrators  
 are to carry this indenture into effect and operation and the said Richard C Gray himself his  
 heirs & assigns covenant with the said John R Bryant that the aforesaid property against  
 the claim or claims of all and every person whomsoever will by these presents warrant and
