

Indenture made and entered into on this 9th day of December, 1832, between
 Benjamin Francis of the first part John M. Whitfield of the second part and Jacob Barnes
 of the third part all three parties of the County of Smithampton in the State of Virginia
 That whereas the said Benjamin Francis is indebted
 to the said Jacob Barnes in the sum of Eighteen dollars and Eighteen Cents which
 will appear as well by Bill as this Indenture and of even date herewith and that said
 Benjamin Francis is willing to secure to the said Jacob Barnes the debt aforesaid together
 with the interest which shall accrue thereon and therefore the said Benjamin Francis
 doth for and in Consideration aforesaid and for the further Consideration of Creditors
 him in to and paid by the said John M. Whitfield at and before the executing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and from every
 part of which he the said John M. Whitfield has then Equities and Administrations as
 before released exonerated and discharged and he the said Benjamin Francis have and
 doth hereby in and for the Consideration aforesaid bargain and sell unto the said John
 M. Whitfield his heirs and assigns the following named property to wit three of four beds
 and furniture two Shirts Two Tables One box One Corn and hamper 2 ewes 3 ewes three
 Barrels One Spinning wheel One pair Cows One head in two parts and heads to
 each, One dutch oven, One hand Saw, One Sledge, One Sheet One Frank part of set of
 and forks also part of set of spurs, To have and to hold each and all the above named property
 and every part thereof unto him the said John M. Whitfield his heirs and assigns forever to and
 for the only proper use before and hereafter written (that is to say) in Trust and to be dispo-
 sed of as follows to wit of the said Benjamin Francis shall in each and every year until
 interest and Costs of executing this Indenture shall be required by the said Jacob Barnes
 his Exors adm or assigns it shall then be lawful and not only lawful but the duty of
 him the said John M. Whitfield his Exor or adm to make sale of all or so much of
 the before named property out auction and for cash as will fully discharge the aforesaid
 interest and Costs of or said first advertising in three or more public places ten days
 previous thereto the time and place of such intended sale and out of the moneys raised
 by such sale pay the said debt interest and Costs of carrying this indenture into
 full operation and the Surplus of any money over to the said Benjamin Francis his
 Exor or adm or such person as shall be legally authorized to receive the same and if the
 said Benjamin Francis shall pay the debt interest and Costs at or before the time being
 required by the said Jacob Barnes his Exor adm or assigns then and in that case
 the said John M. Whitfield his Exor or adm shall certify in writing a discharge
 from such trust the property hereinbefore named thereby releasing the same from their
