Have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Eder and Gramples his heirs and assigns a tract or parcel of Land containing fifty Eight acres more or less being three tracts in value of the tract of Land of which William Fowler did die seized and possessed and bounded as follows.
