This Indenture made this 27<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
thirty two by and between Thomas Lawrence and Martha Lawrence his wife of the County of Southampton  
State of Virginia of the one part and Ipho Parker of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witness  
eth that the said Thomas Lawrence and Martha Lawrence his wife for an consideration of the  
sum of four hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Ipho Parker at or before the making  
and delivery of this present the lawful value of they the said Thomas Lawrence and Martha  
Lawrence his wife do hereby acknowledge themselves to the said date for contained and  
Ipho Parker his wife have granted bargained sold aloted and confirmed and by these presents do grant bar-  
gained sold aloted and confirmed him the said Ipho Parker his heirs and assigns forever  
a certain tract or parcel of land being in the County of Southampton bounded as follows begin-  
ning at a corner of the land Ipho Parker below a small branch thence running a long the said  
Parker's line to the Indian Branch a corner of Luddon's line thence up the same to the corner corner  
of the said Branch to a corner of Miles Lawrence and Hardy Davis thence along the said  
Lawrence's line to the main road leading from Davis' Gap to Sims' Station thence along the  
Garrison's line to a corner of John Cobb's line along the said Cobb's line to the first station  
containing by estimation one hundred and twenty two and a half acres to the same more  
or less together with the reversion or reversions remainder or remainders of present profits  
thereof to have and to hold the said bargained premises with the appurtenances  
and advantages of every kind what over to the said tract belonging to him the said Ipho  
Parker and his heirs and assigns forever and they the said Thomas Lawrence and Martha  
Lawrence his wife for themselves their executors and administrators do and will by  
these presents warrant and forever defend the said bargained premises with the  
appurtenances aforesaid against the lawful claims of all and every person or persons  
what over unto him the said Ipho Parker his heirs and assigns forever. In testimony  
whereof they the said Thomas Lawrence and Martha Lawrence his wife have set to  
set their hands and affixed on seals this day and year of our Lord alone written

husband of Miles.

Commonwealth's Justices of the peace in and for the said County of Martha Lawrence wife of  
Thomas Lawrence a party to the aforesaid deed of bargain and sale who being by us examined  
separate and apart from her said husband acknowledged the said writing to be her  
act and deed and that she executed it freely and voluntarily and without the procurement  
or influence of her said husband that she wishes not to retract it, but that this her acknowledgment  
should be certified and recorded in the County Court of Southampton Escon  
under our hands and seals this 1<sup>st</sup> day of October 1830.
