hereby acknowledged: They the said Elizab. Symes and Martha his wife both given and  
are bargained, sold, alen'd, enfeoff'd, released and Confirmed, and by these presents  
doth give grant, bargain sell alen'd enfeoff'd, release and Confirm to the said Elizab. Symes  
his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County  
of Southampton, in the State of Virginia, containing by estimation One hundred and  
Seven acres more or less being the tract purchased of Eli Symes called the Silver Tract,  
which Eli Symes did say is unfeoffed, and covering the several tracts or parcels  
purchased of Madeliah, Alfred Oberry and Harry Oberry, Thomas Etob and Pety  
his wife and James Scott, all of which need fully appear by reference to the respective  
deeds and bounded by the road leading to Somerton. The lands belonging to Pety, John  
Matthew Drake, Nathaniel Greenham, and Martha Symes with all and singular the  
appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging to or in any way appertaining  
unto all the Estate right title and interest of the said Elizab. Symes and Martha his  
wife in and to the said granted or intended to be granted tract or parcel of land and  
promised. To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be granted  
tract or parcel of land and promised with its appurtenances unto the said Iape Sank-  
ford his heirs adms and assigns forever to the only purpose and behoof of the  
said Iape Sankford his heirs & forever. And the said Elizab. Symes and Martha his wife  
wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators distinctly covenant promise  
and agree to and with the said Iape Sankford his heirs & forever. in manner and  
form following that is to say that the said Elizab. Symes and Martha his wife  
their heirs Executors & the aforesaid tract or parcel of land and premises with their  
appurtenances unto the said Iape Sankford his heirs Executors and administrators  
against all persons whatever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these  
presentes. Upon this never to舍p that the said Iape Sankford his heirs  
and administrators shall permit the said Elizab. Symes and Martha his wife to  
remove in quiet and peaceable possession of the said tract of land with its appurte-  
nances and take the profits thereof to themselves over, until defauult be made in the  
payment of the said sum of two hundred and fifty Seven dollars and fifty Cents
