Court day forenoon to the day of Sale, and out of the monies arising from such sale shall be paid off all
expenses the Charge thereof and all other expenses attending the promised pay to the said Elizabt^t
Power, her heirs Executors & C the sum of Two hundred and fifty Seven dollars and fifty Cents
with the interest which may thereon lawfully have accrued; and the balance, if any shall
pay to the said Elizabt^t Power and his wife that his Executors administrators each
Eighty: But of the whole of the said sum of Two hundred and fifty Seven dollars and fifty Cents
