

Lewis *This* Indenture made and entered into this 21st day of August in the year one
 To thousand eight hundred and thirty two between Zebulon Lewis of the first part Luitlen R.
 Mason Edwards of the second part and John P. Mason of the third part all being of the County of
 Southampton in Virginia Whereas the said Zebulon Lewis is indebted to the said John
 P. Mason in the sum of five hundred dollars and eleven cents due by bond bearing date
 date with these presents and payable on demand the 1st day of January next and is
 desirous of securing the payment thereof by certain Indenture with which he
 and in consideration of the premises and of the sum of one dollar to him the said
 Lewis by him the said Edwards in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of
 these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the Zebulon Lewis has
 bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain sell and convey unto the said
 Luitlen R. Edwards the following negro slaves to wit: one man Dick and
 his child Francis and David, with their future increase to him and his heirs forever
 or assigns forever Upon Trust never that if the said Zebulon Lewis is to retain
 possession of the said negro slaves until default shall be made in payment of the
 said sum of money on demand thereof being made after the said 1st day of January 1833
 when the said Luitlen R. Edwards hereby is required by the said Mason to take
 possession of the said negro slaves and any increase which may have been produced
 and after advertising the time and place of sale for ten days at the Court house door shall sell
 the same to the highest bidder for Cash and of the proceeds of such sale shall pay first
 the expenses of this trust and the debt aforesaid and account entered remaining paid
 to the said Mason or his Ex. or assigns and the balance of any profits the said
 Lewis or his Order. And the said Lewis Covenant with the said Edwards that he
 shall have possession of the said slaves for the purposes aforesaid and a guarantee to the
 said slaves and increase. And the said Edwards Covenant that he will faithfully
 execute the trust hereby Confided to him. And the said Mason Covenant that this
 incumbrance shall be released on payment of the said debt and interest. In Testi-
