 held and firmly bound unto the President and Directors of the Literary fund and trust and  
 to which payment due and truly to be made to the said President and Directors of  
 the Literary Fund and their successors in Office we bind ourselves Executors  
 and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals  
 and dated this 18<sup>th</sup> day of December 1832.

The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Elias  
 Summersell was on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1832 by the School Commissioners and Gates  
 David County of Northampton appointed their Treasurer for the year ending the 31<sup>st</sup> December  
 1832. In full of the said Elias Summersell shall faithfully apply and account for all moneys  
 which may come to his hands by virtue of his Office and shall do perform and execute  
 all and every act and thing appertaining to the said Office according to law then the  
 obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue Elias Summersell and  
 James Nichols Clerk's Office of Northampton County Court. James Nichols Clerk

This Bond being to the form presented and showing thereof being or may opening good and  
 sufficient, was acknowledged & received and read to record and filed in this Office according

 This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of December 1832 between William H. Nichols and  
 Melissa F. his wife of the first part and James Taylor of the other part Witnesses that the said  
 William H. Nichols and wife for and in consideration of the sum of twenty three dollars and 90<sup>cs</sup>  
 to them in hand paid by the said James Taylor at the execution of these presents the receipt of  
 which is hereby acknowledged have granted, sold and sold and by these presents do grant  
 bargain and sell to the said James Taylor a certain parcel of land a part of the tract granted  
 of Joseph Briggs lying and being within the County of Northampton N<sup>o</sup>. containing twenty four and  
 a half acres and bounded as follows beginning at a corner piece for Prop<sup>r</sup> & P<sup>r</sup> of said James Taylor  
 and running N 57<sup>o</sup> 30' E. 113 poles thence S 89<sup>o</sup> 30' E. 100 poles to a point and  
 made Corner thence S 16. E. 129 poles a new line to which it strikes the old line and thence the  
 line between James Taylor & Co. and said parcel of land to the beginning. To have and to hold  
 the said parcel of land with all and singl<sup>r</sup> and the appurtenances thereto belonging unto  
 any way appertaining, free from the claims or claims of us the said William H. Nichols &  
 Melissa Frances my wife or any other person or persons whatsoever and we the said  
 William H. Nichols and wife on our part do warrant and defend to the said James  
 Taylor his heirs and assigns forever a full and clear right and title to the said parcel
