Williams John Adventure made this 19th day of September in the year of our Lord 1832 between John R. Williams
of the first part, John T. Blow Jr. of the second part and Cuthbert D. Barnham of the third
part Whereas the Said John T. Blow Jr. on the 19th day of February in the year of our Lord 1831 in
order to secure the payment of the sum of six hundred and fifty dollars and Eighty five cents
to the said Cuthbert D. Barnham did by indenture of trust of that date convey to the said John R.
Williams his heirs Executors & the factors of the following property to the use of certain trades or parts of land
containing twenty acres to the same more or less known by the name of the Crop Keys and some
as the said land described in trust for the uses and purposes in the said Adventure mentioned
and whereas since the executing and delivering of the said deed of trust the said John T.
Blow Jr. hath partly satisfied and paid to the said Cuthbert D. Barnham the sum of two
hundred and fifty dollars in part partly secured which the said Cuthbert D. Barnham doth
hereby acknowledge Now this Adventure witnesseth that for the considerations
aforementioned as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said
John T. Blow Jr. to the said John R. Williams at and before the executing and delivery
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and to the said John R.
Williams which the agent of the said Cuthbert D. Barnham signified by his attorney
is this present and the said Cuthbert D. Barnham having granted bargained and sold remiss
released and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell him a release and
covenant unto the said John T. Blow Jr. all the right title interest claim and demand both
at law and in equity what the said John R. Williams and Cuthbert D. Barnham have or
hold in a certain part of the above described land saying and thereafter aces to the west of
the house and lot formerly occupied by the said J. C. Cummings and bounded as follows
beginning in the road at a new corner said John T. Blow in Sampson River's line
thence along said John T. Blow's line 37^{1/2} E 18^{1/2} poles to a corner thereat 155. W 15^{1/2} poles
to a new corner said John T. Blow on said Sampson C. River's line thence along said
S. C. River's line S 26^{1/2} W 11^{1/2} poles to a corner on said road thence along the road N 37^{1/2}
E 16^{1/2} poles to the first station. To have and to hold the said land and thereunto
aera of land to the only proportion and behoof of him the said John T. Blow Jr. his
heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said John R. Williams and Cuthbert
D. Barnham for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators the above mentioned land
unto the said John T. Blow Jr. his heirs Executors administrators and assigns in a full and ample
manner as he same was warranted by the said John T. Blow Jr. by the said Deed of trust
above recited to warrant the same to the said John T. Blow Jr. against the claims or demands
of them the said John R. Williams & Cuthbert D. Barnham and all persons claiming by or
