This Indenture made and Entered into this 12th day of January 1833 Between a Matthew Williams and Margaret his wife of the one part and Henry Harris of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said Matthew Williams and Margaret his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and twenty dollars to them in hand paid or secured to be paid by the said Henry Harris have granted granted and sold and do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Harris the Certain Tracts or parcel of land adjoining each other lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia near Black Water Bridge one of which pieces contains thirty acres be the same more or less it being the land which said Matthew Williams purchased from Commissioners appointed by the Court of Southampton to sell the lands of Ephraim Turner dec'd the boundaries of which will appear by reference to two Commissioners to Williams the other Tract or piece of Land containing One Hundred and twenty four acres be the same more or less it being the same Land which John Williams purchased from Isaac Ruppel and wife by conveyance in the County of Southampton near Black Water Bridge for the boundaries refer to Ruppel from Ruppel and wife to Williams To Have and to hold the said two pieces or Tracts of Land to him the said Henry Harris his heirs and assigns forever and the said Matthew Williams and Margaret his wife for themselves their heirs &c. do hereby forever warrant and defend the right and Title of the said two pieces or Tracts of Land to him the said Henry Harris and his heirs and assigns forever against the Claims or Claims of all persons what so ever In Testimony whereof the said Matthew Williams and Margaret his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first above written
