This Indenture made and Entered into this 12th day of January 1833 Between a Matthew Williams and Henry and his wife of the one part and Henry Harris of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas it is agreed that the said Matthew Williams and Margaret his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of Three hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid or to be paid by the said Henry Harris have granted bar- gained and sold and doth by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Henry Harris his certain tract or parcel of land adjoining each other lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia near Black Water Bridge one of which pieces of land truly acres be the same more or less to Henry the land which said Matthew Williams purchased from James Phipps appointed by the Court of Southampton to sell the lands of Ephraim Turner dec'd the boundaries of which will appear by reference to his Commissaries to Williams the other tract or piece of Land Containing one hundred and Twenty four acres be the same more or less to Henry the same land which John Williams purchased from Daniel Phipps and wife by me in the County of Southampton near Black Water Bridge for boundaries refer to Deed from Phipps and wife to Williams To have and to hold the said properties or tracts of Land to him the said Henry Harris his heirs and assigns forever and the said Matthew Williams and Margaret his wife for themselves their heirs &c do hereby give warrant and defend the right and title of the said two pieces or tracts of Land to him the said Henry Harris and his heirs and assigns forever against the claim or claims of all persons what ever In Testimony whereof the said Matthew Williams and Margaret his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first above written
