This Indenture made this 21st day of January in the year of our Lord 1833 between George et C Barham and William & Rochelle Samuel Barham and Wren of the first part and Joseph Brown of the other part. Whereas the said Joseph Brown on the 10th day of February in the year of our Lord 1824, in Order to have the payment of the sum of Eleven hundred and twenty One dollars and 25 Cents to the said Rochelle Barham and Wren and their heirs Esrs & C others during his/their/their property took a tract of Land containing three hundred acres more or less on the West side of Stoney River upon trust for the use and purpose in the said Indenture mentioned above whereas since the executing and delivering of the said deed of trust the said Joseph Brown hath fully satisfied and paid to the said Rochelle Barham and Wren the several sums of money therby bound which the said Rochelle Barham and Wren doth hereby acknowledge and say this Indenture witnesseth that for the Consideration aforesaid as well as for the further Consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Joseph Brown to the said George et C Barham and Rochelle Barham and Wren at and before the making and delivery of this present receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said George et C Barham and Rochelle Barham and Wren doth the first and appellation of the said Rochelle Barham and Wren signified by his being party to this present and the said George et C Barham have granted bargained and sold unto the said and confirmed and by this present do grant bargain and sell him release and confirm unto the said Joseph Brown all the estate right title interest claim and demand both at Law and in Equity which the said George et C Barham and William & Rochelle Samuel Barham and Barham Wren now or hold in the land above described to him and to hold the tract of Land above described aforesaid while the said Joseph Brown his heirs & assigns forever to the only proper and behoof of the Joseph Brown his heirs & assigns forever and the said George et C Barham and William & Rochelle Samuel Barham and Barham Wren then and there doth this Esrs & C do to the above mentioned tract of Land unto the said Joseph Brown his heirs & assigns full and ample manner as the same was or may be by the Joseph Brown against the claim or claim of the said George et C Barham and William & Rochelle Samuel Barham and Barham Wren and all persons claiming by or under them or either of them.
