

Barham This Indenture made this 21st day of January in the year of our Lord 1833 between
 To George et al Barham and William L Rochelle Samuel Barham and Barham of the first part &
 Wherein Joseph Brown of the other part Whereas the said Joseph Brown on the 18th day of February
 in the year of our Lord 1829 in order to secure the payment of the sum of Eleven pounds
 and six pence One dollar and 25 Cents to the said Rochelle Barham and Brown and
 their heirs Executors &c the following property to wit a tract of Land containing three hundred
 acres more or less on the West side of a certain River upon trust for the use and pur-
 poses in the said Indenture mentioned and whereas since the executing and
 delivering of the said Deed of trust the said Joseph Brown hath fully satisfied
 and paid to the said Rochelle Barham and Brown the several sums of money
 thereby secured which the said Rochelle Barham and Brown do hereby acknowledge
 And this Indenture witnesseth that for the consideration of so much as would be for
 the further consideration of One dollar in hand paid by the said Joseph Brown to the
 said George et al Barham and Rochelle Barham and Brown at and before the execut-
 ing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said
 George et al Barham and Rochelle Barham and Brown with the assent and approbation
 of the said Rochelle Barham and Brown signified by his being party to these presents
 and the said George et al Barham have granted bargained and sold remised and
 confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell remise release and confirm
 unto the said unto the said Joseph Brown all the whole right title interest claim
 and demand both at Law and in Equity which the said George et al Barham and
 William L Rochelle Samuel Barham and Barham Brown have or hold in the land
 above described To have and to hold the said tract of Land above described aforesaid unto the
 said Joseph Brown his heirs Executors and assigns forever to the only proper heirs and
 assigns of the said Joseph Brown his heirs and assigns forever and the said George et al Bar-
 ham and William L Rochelle Samuel Barham and Barham Brown themselves and
 their Executors do unto the above mentioned tract of Land unto the said Joseph Brown
 his heirs Executors &c as full and ample warrant as the same ever was or may be
 by the said Joseph Brown against the claim or claims of the said George et al Barham
 and William L Rochelle Samuel Barham and Barham Brown and all persons
 claiming by or under them or either of them In Witness whereof the said parties to
 these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and year
 first above written
