

This Indenture made this 25th day of January one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three
 between Joseph Brown and Martha his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Sally
 Brown of the same County of the other part witnesseth that the said Joseph Brown and Martha
 Brown his wife in Consideration of Thirteen hundred dollars of Lawful money of this sum
 which to them is hand paid by the said Sally Brown at or before the concluding and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained
 and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said
 Sally Brown her heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying
 and bounded the aforesaid County of Southampton on the West side of a stream River
 Containing three hundred acres more or less and bounded by the lands of George Blunt
 Bahamas M'Graw and Martha Jones it being a part of the land formerly owned
 by Thomas Gilliam the Elder and of late years has been by the name of Thompson's place
 which was sold by Commissioners to Thomas G Tucker and by him to the said Joseph
 Brown together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges the
 possession and revenues to consider and remanders of all and singular the said tract
 or parcel of Land hereby granted and all houses, rents, estates, conveniences, servants
 belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and to hold the said tract of
 land and all other the premises hereby granted Bargained and sold unto the said
 Sally Brown her heirs and assigns forever to the only purpose and intent of the
 the said Sally Brown her heirs and assigns forever And the said Joseph Brown and
 Martha Brown his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land
 with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said
 Sally Brown her heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Joseph
 Brown and Martha Brown his wife or either of them their or either of their heirs shall
 need and do warrant and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof
 the said Joseph Brown and Martha Brown his wife have hereunto set their hands
 affixing their seals the day and year first above written.
