This Indenture made on the 19th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three between James Wick of the County of Southampton of the one part and Messieurs William of the same County of the other part all the objects: That the said James Wick in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars in hand paid the presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Messieurs Mellons and his heirs not that tract or parcel of Land which the said Messieurs Mellons and Pippin wife conveyed to him by deed of Indenture bargain and sale bearing date the 15th day of October 1830. as is referenced therein unto his wife well more fully appearing containing fifty acres by more in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded as in the aforementioned deed from Mellons and wife to the said James Wick. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land as in the afore mentioned deed described to him the said Messieurs Mellons and his heirs for ever and the said James Wick for himself his heirs Executors and administrators the aforementioned tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances unto him the said Messieurs Mellons against all persons claiming under or from the said James Wick well: release and for ever defend in evidence whereof the said James Wick hath hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written Signed sealed and delivered (The Signed 19th of January) entered James Wick (and in presence of before signed in the first line)

This Indenture made the 12th day of January 1833 between Messieurs Mellons and Miles Shado both of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia with the objects that Mellons for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Miles Shado had bargain and sold and by these presents did bargain and sell unto the said Messieurs Mellons all that tract and parcel of Land lying situate and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to wit on the East by the lands of William Davis north by James Johnsons land formerly Madis West by the lands of Geo Wick and South by Anthony Swamp. To have and to hold the said tract and parcel of Land and the appurtenances thereto belonging to him and his heirs forever. Containing by estimation thirty acres be the same more or less. And the said Miles Shado do hereby give grant bargain and sell unto the said Messieurs Mellons and his heirs and assigns for him the Claim or Claims of all and every person whatsoever warrant and for ever defend by their presents.
