of the sum of Three hundred Dollars Current money of this Commonwealth to him given and paid by the said Henry Mayt at or before the concluding and delivery of these presents  
to the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge to have granted bargained sold alured  
of ceded and Conveyed and by these presents do grant bargaine sell alienage off  
and Convey unto the said Henry Mayt at his heirs and assigns forever all the  
right title interest claim or demand which he the said Everett E Mayt had in one  
certain undivided tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being  
in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes Containing by  
Estimation two hundred acres be the same more or less it being the tract or parcel  
of land wherein the said Henry Mayt now resides and sojournereth to them  
the said Henry Mayt and Everett E Mayt by the last will and Testament of  
James Mayt dec<sup>d</sup> and bounded by the Cypress Swamp and the lands of John White
