 a certain tract of land as expressed in the said deed reference thereto well fully expressed
 and the said Parsons having paid or otherwise secured to the said Strong Esq the debt
 aforesaid and having requested the said Parsons to release and convey to him the
 land aforesaid. This Indenture Witnessed that the said Parsons for and in
 consideration of the premises by and with the consent of the said John R Strong Esq and
 for the further consideration of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Jemmes
 before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 Edgar hath granted bargained sold aliened released and conveyed to the said John R Strong
 Esq his heirs or assigns all right title interest claim or demand which the said Parsons
 hath in and to the aforesaid lands conveyed in trust as aforesaid and the same to the
 said Jemmes his heirs and assigns and defend against the claim
 of him the said Parsons or all and every person or persons claiming title or interest
 therein in by or through him in all things whereof the said John R Strong Esq
 would have signed sealed and acknowledged the same this day and date first written
