Parsons & Jones This Indenture made this 29th of December 1832 Between Edgar Parsons of the County of Southampton of the Parish of St. Nicholas and John Jones of the third part. All to wit that whereas the said Jones by deed of Release the Clerk's Office of Southampton County dated the 19 day of January 1832 do gave and conveyed unto the said Parsons for the purposes aforesaid a certain tract of land as expressed in the said deed reference thereto well fully appearing that the said Jones having found or otherwise secured to the said Jones & Co the title aforesaid and having requested the said Parsons to release and recover the same from the land aforesaid. This Indenture doth witness that the said Parsons for and in consideration of the premises by and with the consent of the said R. Thompson and for the further consideration of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Jones do hereby the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained sold aliened released and conveyed to the said John Jones his heirs or assigns all right title interest claim or demand which the said Parsons hath and to the aforesaid lands conveyed in trust as aforesaid and the same to the said Jones his heirs and assigns doth hereby warrant and defend against the claim of him the said Parsons or all or every person or persons claiming title or interest therein in by or through him in all things whereof the said Jones and his heirs and assigns doth have signed sealed and acknowledged the same this day and date first written
