 the Said William Allen have bargained sold aliened and conveyed and Con-
 firmed and by these presents do bargain sell alien convey and Con-
 firm the Said William Bryant his heirs and assigns the following piece or parcel of Land Situated
 lying and being in Said State of Virginia On the South Side of Cypress Swamp lying
 the lot of Land that fell to the heirs of Benjamin Ellis dec^d. by the death of that noble
 Just. Laurence. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract of Land with its appur-
 tenances to him the Said William Bryant and his heirs and the Said William
 Allen do hereby against himself his heirs and assigns warrant and defend the
 aforesaid land to the Said William Bryant his heirs and assigns In Witness
 whereof I the Said William Allen hereunto set my hand and Seal this 16th day
 of July 1832.
