 Eight hundred and thirty one Between John W. Blund and Sarah his wife of the County
 of Transylvania and State of Virginia of the first part and Liddellberry Mason of the County
 of Southampton and State aforesaid of the second part. Witnesseth that for and in
 consideration of the sum of Eighteen thousand Two hundred and thirty dollars
 to him in hand paid by the said Liddellberry Mason the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged that the said John W. Blund and Sarah his wife have sold unto
 the said Liddellberry Mason his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel
 of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid on the North side
 of the Meherrin River and containing by Estimation One thousand Eight hundred
 and fifty three acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows on the
 East side by the lands of a Robert P. Smith on the South side of a Meherrin
