This Indenture Witnesseth that the said James Magel Trustee aforesaid for and in Consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars do him and his heirs and assigns paid by the said William Orens at and before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James Magel Trustee doth hereby bargain sell alien enfeoff convey and confirm unto the said William Orens his heirs assigns heirs and assigns forever all the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land containing two hundred acres more or less aforesaid with the appurtenances and tenements thereunto belonging with all right title interest claim or demand of or unto the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land with all the hereditaments and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining To have and to hold to him the said William Orens his heirs assigns heirs and assigns forever in as full and complete manner as the said Trustee is empowered by virtue of his trust aforesaid and further the said James Magel Trustee doth hereby Covenant promise and grant to and with the said William Orens his heirs and assigns who shall and may from time to time and at all times hereafter have hold occupy possess or enjoy the said premises with the appurtenances free and clear of and from all incumbrances that have been or committed by him the said James Magel Trustee will retain and defend the same to the said William Orens his heirs or assigns forever So far as he the said James Magel Trustee is authorized by virtue of the aforesaid Deed in Trust and no further. Know all men by these presents that we William Davis Peter Pierce and Robert Ricks are held and firmly bound unto John Floyd Esquire Governor or Chief Magistrate of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of five thousand dollars. In which sum may well and truly to be made to the said Governor for the time being and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth within months execution and a bond jointly and severally firmly by these presents and date this 18th day of February 1833.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named William Davis has been duly appointed by the County Court of Southampton to serve as Constable in the lower district of St. Mary's Parish in the County of Southampton until June Court 1834. If the said William Davis shall well and truly discharge the duties of the said Office of Constable in the said County during the continuance thereof then the above obligation to be void and to remain void free and void
