Bowers Know all men by these presents that we have Bonded James Rockelle, Clements Rockelle,
 To William B. Goodwyn and Jesse Lankford are held and firmly bound unto John Floyd Esq
 Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the full and full term of thirty thousand Dollars
 to be paid to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth for the
 payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us our
 and each of our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these
 presents Sealed with our seals and dated this 18th day of February 1833
 The Conditions of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Carr
 Bowers constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission
 from the Governor under the Seal of the Commonwealth dated the 22nd day of
 January 1833 for the term of one year from and after the next quarterly Court to be held
 for the said County in the year 1833. If therefore the said Carr Bowers shall well and
 truly collect all taxes and poor rates and account for and pay the same in such man-
 ner as is by Law directed and also all fines forfeitures and other moneys accruing or
 becoming due to the Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and
 pay the same to the Treasurer of this Commonwealth for the time being for the use
 of the Commonwealth in like manner as is or shall be directed in case of public Taxes
 and shall in all other things truly and faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff
 during his Continuance therein the above obligation to be void is also to remain in full
 force and virtue
