 to be paid to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth. To the
 payment whereof we will and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us and
 and each of our heirs Executors and Administrators firmly and severally for the sum aforesaid
 presently sealed with our seals and dated this 18th day of February 1833

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Mr
 Bowers constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by
 Commission from the Governor under the Seal of the Commonwealth dated the 27th
 January 1833 for the term of one year from and after the next quarterly Court to be held
 for the said County in the year 1833. If therefore the said Mr Bowers shall will and
 truly collect all taxes and poor rates and account for and pay the same in due man-
 ner as is by Law directed and also all fines for future and amounts accrued
 to be coming due to the Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and
 pay the same to the Treasurer of this Commonwealth for the time being for the use
 of the Commonwealth in like manner as is or shall be directed in case of public Taxes
 and shall in all other things truly and faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff
 during his continuance therein the above obligation to be void unless to remain in full
 force and virtue
