The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Caro Bowers
 is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from
 the Governor under the Seal of the Commonwealth dated the day of January 1833 for the
 term of one year from the first Quarterly Court to be holden for the County aforesaid in the
 year 1833. If therefore the said Caro Bowers shall truly and faithfully collect account
 for and pay the taxes imposed by Law and all arrearages of taxes due in the said
 County of Southampton also truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the Militia
 dues in the said County of Southampton aforesaid and all arrearages of Militia dues
 due in the said County and shall in all things truly and faithfully execute the said
 Office of Sheriff during his Continuance therein then the above obligation shall
 be void or else to remain in full force and virtue
