Goddard and Jesse Lambford are held and firmly bound unto John Floyd Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the mol and full sum of thirty thousand dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his heirs or for the use of the Commonwealth for the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs, Executors, and administrators jointly and severally jointly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 18th day of February 1833.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above named Car. Bowers is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a commission from the Governor under the Seal of the Commonwealth dated the day of January 1833 for the term of one year from the first Quarterly Court to be holden for the County aforesaid in the year 1833. If therefore the said Car. Bowers shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the taxes imposed by Law and all arrearages of taxes due in the said County of Southampton also truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the Militia fines due in the said County of Southampton aforesaid and all arrearages of Militia fines due in the said County and shall in all things truly and faithfully execute the said Office of Sheriff during his continuance therein then the above obligation shall be void or else to remain in full force and virtue Signed, sealed and acknowledged in open Court.
