Whithead This Indenture made and entered into this 4th day of February one thousand and eight hundred and thirty three between Edwin Whithead and Martha Eder wife of Francis Whithead County State of Virginia of the one part and Hannah Whithead of Southampton and State aforesaid of the other part Metrespoke that the said Edwin Whithead and Martha Eder wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said Hannah Whithead the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged in truth by these presents granted bargained and sold one certain grant bargain and sell unto the said Hannah Whithead her heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton containing by a later survey three hundred and fifty one acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of John Newton Newton Harris, Josephus Henders, Wm. Brown's heirs and the heirs of Samuel Turner. And the said Edwin Whithead and Martha Eder wife for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven hundred dollars and assigns shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend the title to the foregoing land and premises and every part thereof unto the said Hannah Whithead her heirs and assigns forever against whomsoever they shall and against all and every other person and persons, whatsover. All which the said Edwin Whithead and Martha Eder wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date above written.
