Know all men by these presents that the 18 day of February 1833. Between Henry W. Corbett and his wife of the County of Isle of Wight of the one part and Jonathan Santhford of the County of Southampton of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Henry W. Corbett and his wife in Consideration of twenty three dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Jonathan Santhford at or before the entering in and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Jonathan Santhford his heirs and assigns a Certain Tract or parcel of Land Containing seven acres be the same more or less lying near black water river and bounded as follows. Beginning at a poplar gum standing in Jack's branch a Corner tree of Harrison's grant and said Tract thence along the branch to a small white oak a Corner tree of said land and of Zachariah Santhford thence along a line of marked trees to a large Cypress standing in the Edge of the river islands thence along the islands to a small Hickory a Corner tree of said Land and Zachariah Santhford thence along Harrison's line to the first station together with all the houses, yards, barns, outbuildings, gardens, Orchards, lands, tenements, meadows, pastures, Common woods, and other premises, profits, Easements, Commodities, advantages and emoluments, hereditaments, and appointments whosoever to the said tract of Land belonging or appertaining or unto the same used and enjoyed or accepted or reputed taken or known as parcel or member thereof or as belonging to the same or any part thereof and all the revenues and revenues thereon and hereunder yearly and other rents, issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold to the said Jonathan Santhford his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of them the said Jonathan Santhford his heirs and assigns forever and to the
