Corbett and Corbett his wife of the County of Isle of Wight of the one part and Jonathan Santhford of the County of Southampton of the other part. Whereof it is shewed that the said Henry W. Corbett and wife in Consideration of twenty three dollars of lawful money then communicated to them in hand paid by the said Jonathan Santhford at or before the entering in and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth buy and sell unto the said Jonathan Santhford his heirs and assigns a Certain tract or parcel of Land containing seven acres be the same more or less lying near black water river and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a *pe pe* gum standing in Jack's branch a Corner tree of Mainw. Spring and said tract thence along the branch to a small white oak a Corner tree of said land and of Zachariah Santhford thence along a line of marked trees to a large Cypress standing in the Edge of the river islands thence along the islands to a small Hickory a Corner tree of said Land and Zachariah Santhford thence along Mainw.
