Gordon dec'd of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the one part and Wilson Gordon of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Tabitha Gardner for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and Ninety nine dollars and twenty Seven Cents to her own hands paid by the said Wilson Gardner and before the ensingling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Tabitha Gardner hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargaine and sell unto the said Wilson Gardner his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land by means lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded and bounded as follows Beginning at a point in the late Boundary line of the County & line a corner of the lower line thence a straight line to a gum on the Poplar Islands branch thence up the branch to a gum or corner thence a straight line
