Wicks This Indenture made this 19 day of February 1833 Between Jason Hicks of the first part John W. Thomas of the second part and John W. Gentry of the third part
Gentry Whereas the said Jason Hicks is jointly indebted to the said John W. Gentry by note bearing date March three present and payable on demand for the sum of forty dollars and twenty two cents which note with the interest thereon according to the said Jason Hicks is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Jason Hicks for and in Consideration of the premises and for the further Consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said John W. Thomas at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledges he the said Jason Hicks has granted bargained and sold and by these presents does grant bargain and sell unto the said John W. Thomas the following property to wit One bay horse three head of Cattle One bed and furniture, three Sheep One cow and ten pigs Eight Bunches of Corn One thousand pounds blood fodder for many winters of Every kind and Kitchen furniture and about Eight hundred pounds Salt pork To have and to hold the hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted property unto him the said John W. Thomas his heirs executors and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said John W. Thomas his heirs executors and assigns forever And the said Jason Hicks for himself his heirs executors and assigns do hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said John W. Thomas his heirs executors and administrators forever in manner and form following that is to say that the said Jason Hicks his heirs executors and assigns the aforesaid property unto the said John W. Thomas his heirs executors and assigns against all persons whatsoever Whom and well were suit and of us defend by these presents Upon these Writings that the said John W. Thomas his heirs executors and administrators shall permit the said Jason Hicks to remain in quiet and peaceable possession of the aforesaid property and take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the aforesaid sum of forty dollars and twenty two cents either in the whole or in part and then upon this further Trust that the said John W. Thomas his heirs executors and assigns shall and do soon after the happening of such default of payment or his heirs executors and assigns may think proper or the said John W. Gentry his heirs executors and assigns shall request all the said personal property hereby conveyed or such part of the hereby granted premises as the Trustor his legal representatives hereby authorized to act shall think proper permit for the purpose and shall think proper to sell to the highest bidder for
