Little the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert P. Little and his heirs &c. my interest in that undivided tract of land which was allotted to me and Joseph P. Little out of the Land of John P. Little dec^d as the Commission's report will more fully show and containing by a late Survey two hundred and sixty two acres or thereabouts being the one tenth part of the land allotted to allan P. Little dec^d by said Commission and bounded as follows, on the north by the land belonging to said Robert P. Little on the south by the land belonging to the estate of allan P. Little dec^d on the east by the land belonging to Joseph P. Little and on the west by the land belonging to Thomas P. Little To have and to hold the said tract or parcels of land together with all and singular their appurtenances to him the said Robert P. Little and his heirs forever and the said Richard P. Little his heirs and assigns and admors that of the said tract or parcels of Land with their appurtenances to him the said Robert P. Little his heirs and assigns shall and will forever warrant and defend. In witness whereof the said Richard P. Little has hereunto set his hand and seal this day and date above written.
