Richard P. Hill Indenture made this 17 day of March in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty three Between Richard P. Hill of the County of Meigs, and State of Ohio of the one part. Hill and Robert P. Hill of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part. Witness that the said Richard P. Hill in consideration of the sum of three hundred and seventy five dollars to him in hand paid by the said Robert P. Hill the receipt whereof is her by acknowledged have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert P. Hill and his heirs &c. my right etc in that considered tract of land which was allotted to me and Joseph P. Hill out of the Lands of Joseph P. Hill dec^d as the Commission report will more fully show and containing by a late Survey two hundred and sixty two acres or so also my interest being the one tenth part of the land allotted to Mary Ann P. Hill dec^d by said Commission and bounded as follows, on the north by the land belonging to said Robert P. Hill on the south by the land belonging to the estate of Mary Ann P. Hill dec^d on the east by the land belonging to Joseph P. Hill and on the west by the line belonging to Thomas Hill dec^d To have and to hold the said tract or parcels of land together with all and singular their appurtenances to him the said Robert P. Hill and his heirs forever and the said Richard P. Hill his heirs Executors and Administrators thereof and his heirs forever as parcels of Land with their appurtenances to him the said Robert P. Hill his heirs and assigns shall and will forever warrant and defend. In witness whereof the said Richard P. Hill has hereunto set his hand and seal this day and date above written
