 said Orms & Brown shall convey his interest in remanent to the said John
 Shepherd and Susan his wife in and to the Slaves Charles, Mary, Tom, Peter,
 George and Bethe, helow down by the said John Shepherd in right
 of his wife Susan, who before her enterrman cage with the said John Shepherd
 was the widow of James Lundy dec^d to which the said Orms & Brown, was then
 entitled in fee simple after the death of the said Susan Shepherd in right of her
 wife Susan who was the Only Child, heir and distributee of the said James Lundy
 have granted bargained sold, released and relinquished to the said Orms &
 Brown, all right title and interest which the said John Shepherd and Susan
 his wife have in a tract of Land situate lying and being in the said County of
 Southampton of which the said James Lundy dec^d Judge and possessed, Containing
 by Estimation three hundred acres or the same more or less, and also the following
 negro Slaves to wit, Charles, John, Mary, Tom, Peter, Ephraim, Nathan, Miles, Edw
 Betty, Jimmy, Phillis, Phoebe, Rev, (Wing), Amos, Sam, Sophia, Mary, Jim, James
 Jr, George, P. Wick, Abby, Charles, Isaac, Edmund, Edw, Pat, and Roger, together
 with the increase of the females, which said Land and negroes were allotted
 are held, by the said Susan as her dower and third of the Sale of her former
 husband James Lundy dec^d. To have and to hold the said tract of Land and
 the said negro Slaves to have the said Orms & Brown, he, him, adm^rors and
 assigns forever free from the claim of the said John Shepherd and Susan Shepherd
 and all persons claiming from or under either of them of what said tract of Land
 and negro Slaves possessed or delivered to the said Orms & Brown. In Witness
 whereof the said John Shepherd and Susan his wife have hereunto set their
 hands and seals the day and year first above written.
