 N 4 1/2 poles to a corner in said Road thence along the road S 39 E 16 1/2 poles to the first station
 together with all and singular the appurtenances &c. And the receipt and receiving
 remainder and remainders openly and other tenets open and profits thereof and of every
 part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said Lot of Land with the Tenements
 hereunto and all and singular other the premises hereinbefore mentioned or intended
 to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their right
 meaning and appurtenances unto the said E. D. Barham his heirs and assigns forever
 and the said John T. Blaw and Elizabeth his wife for themselves and their heirs the said

 of the Peace and having been proved in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of December 1832 by
 the oath of Austin Middleton and Alexander Myrick the other Justices of the Peace
 with the Certificate thereof annexed of the proper examination and solemn affirmation of
 power of Elizabeth Blaw wife of John T. Blaw parties thereto admitted to record and
 at a Court held for the County aforesaid the 15th day of April 1833 The said Indenture
 and Certificate were entered upon the records of the day
 Teste James Rockwell C. C.
