C. his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Maryland of the one part and Elizabeth Porter of the County of Sussex and State of Maryland of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Michel Barker, Esq. and E. Barker and Mary A. C. his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and six dollars to them hereof by the said Elizabeth Porter the receipt whereof the said Michel Barker, Esq. and E. Barker and Mary A. C. his wife do hereby acknowledge and confess have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain sell and confirm unto the said Elizabeth Porter one certain tract or parcel of Land, containing eight five acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton, of said and bounded by the lands of the said Elizabeth Porter, Michael Holt, James E. Perry and Edward Reese, Est. To have and to hold possession and enjoy the said tract or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said Elizabeth Porter her heirs and assigns forever, and the said Michel Barker, Esq. and E. Barker and Mary A. C. his wife for themselves and their heirs and assigns against all and every person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and by these presents confirm and witnesseth whereof the said Michel Barker, Esq. and E. Barker and Mary A. C. his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year above written.
