

Know This Indenture made this 15th day of March in the year 1833 by and between **Oris Brown** of the County of Southampton and State of Maryland of the first part and **John Shepherd** of the same County and State of the second part. Witnesseth that the said **Oris Brown** in consideration of the value and worth of all right of the said **Oris Brown** in a certain part or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton of which **Susan Shepherd** the wife of the said **John Shepherd** was once as the widow of her first husband **James Lundy** dec^d and which is now in possession of the said **John Shepherd** by virtue of his intestacy with the said **Susan** and of the further relinquishment of all right title and interest of which the said **John Shepherd** and the said **Susan** have in the slaves which were allotted to her for life and then likewise now living as the widow of the said **James Lundy** whose said tract of land and slaves are more particularly described set forth and named in a Deed bearing even date with this indenture executed by the said **John Shepherd** and **Susan** his wife to the said **Oris Brown**, he the said **Oris Brown** doth grant bargain and sell to the said **John Shepherd** the following slaves to wit, **Clarence** **Henry** **Jim** **Clarence** **John** **Ben** and **Better** being a part of the Negroes held by the said **Susan** in dowry and the said **John Shepherd** and the said **Susan** his wife relinquished and conveyed to the said **Oris Brown** by the Will before referred to To have and to hold to him the said **John Shepherd** his heirs and assigns forever and of him his heirs and assigns forever as to the said **Oris Brown** hath herunto set his hand and seal the day and year first above written

Know This Indenture made this 1st day of March 1833 Between **John Brown** of the County of Southampton of the one part and **Elizabeth Drake** of the same County of the other part. Whereas **Elizabeth Drake** of the said County in order to discharge and provide for the payment of three hundred and fifty seven dollars and eleven Cents due by note to **Edward** **Wells** adm^r of the said **Drake** dec^d in an Indenture bearing date the 10th day of December 1831 and admitted to record in the County Court of Southampton, doth among other things convey to the said **John Brown** a certain tract or parcel of Land containing two hundred and fifty acres more or less at being the tract of land alloted to the said **Elizabeth Drake** in the division of the land of **John** **James** dec^d together with the appurtenances thereto belonging in and in trust for the said **Drake** and with power and authority to sell the said tract of Land and other property for the purpose of paying the said Debt and also expenses attending the execution of the said Trust of the said **Elizabeth Drake** should find to discharge the said Debt.
