

of September then next ensuing and whereas the said Elizabeth Drake has my faith to pay the debt on the day aforesaid when the same was payable and the said Edward Beets adm^r of Thomas Drake dec^d having in conveyance this acquired a sale of the said tract of Land to be made for the purpose aforesaid the said Jesse Drury in execution of the said Trust having given the requisite notice thereof did on the first day of March 1833 upon the premises expose at public auction to the highest bidder for ready money the said tract of Land with its appurtenances and at the sale so made the aforesaid Sampson Little became the purchaser of the said Tract of Land and appurtenances by bidding therefor the sum of Six hundred and fifty dollars which was the highest bid made for the same and that sum he has paid to the said Jesse Drury Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Jesse Drury for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred and fifty Dollars which he has received from the said Sampson Little as mentioned above hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell and convey unto the said Sampson Little his heirs and assigns the same Tract of Land therein before mentioned and described together with the appurtenances thereto belonging To have and to hold the said Tract of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging and all the estate, right, title and interest of the said Drury therein unto the said Sampson Little his heirs and assigns he his and their only proper use and behoof forever And the said Jesse Drury for himself his heirs Executors and assigns doth covenant to and with the said Sampson Little his heirs and assigns that he will forever warrant and defend the said Tract of Land hereby conveyed and the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Sampson Little his heirs and assigns against the claim of the said Jesse Drury and all persons claiming the same or any part thereof by force of title or under him the said Jesse Drury but against the claim of any other person whomsoever In Witness whereof the said Jesse Drury hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and full herein written

Between Joel Prepon of the County of Southampton of the one part and Sham Jordan of the County of Northampton of the other part of the State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Joel Prepon for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to him paid by the said Sham Jordan before the execution of this deed hath bargained and sold unto the said Sham Jordan his heirs and assigns all his right and title or interest in and to a certain tract or part of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation One hundred acres more or less it being all the land lying on the South West side of the Branch mill le and near the house of said Prepon called the Spring house
