This Indenture made this 29th day of January in the year Eight hundred and thirty three Between William A. Hodges of the County of Harrison of the one part and Lafayette Brown of the County of ^{Warren} ~~Southampton~~ and State of North Carolina of the other part Witnesseth that the said William A. Hodges in consideration of the sum of four hundred Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Lafayette Brown at or before the execution and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Lafayette Brown his heirs and assigns One undivided third part of the tract or parcels of land of which his father William Hodges did seized and possessed situate in the County of Southampton the whole tract containing three hundred and Eighty acres more or less and conveyed by Edward Brown and Catharine his wife to the said William Hodges by deed bearing date the 15th day of November in the year 1811 and recorded in the County Court of said County on the 18th day of April in the year 1820 together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said undivided third part of the said tract or parcels of land belonging or appertaining or with the same used and enjoyed or accepted reputed taken or turned as part parcels or members thereof or as belonging to the same or any part thereof and the reverses and Redemptions remainors and remainors of any other tracts pieces and parcels thereof and of every part and parcel thereof to have
