 the third part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of money to wit the
 said Susan after her death in the said land and slaves held by her for life as above of James
 Lewis to him in hand paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt
 whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said John Stephens hath bargained and sold
 these presents with bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin Lewis the following
 negro Slaves to wit Charlotte the wife Mary, Catharine, Edney, Ruth Isaac and
 and their future increase also the tract of Land and appurtenances purchase of Edwin
 Pollard for the benefit of the said Susan subject to a Debt of Bond to Allen Mabry
 To have and to hold to him and his heirs forever on Trust never to sell that the said
 Benjamin Lewis shall suffer the said John Stephens to retain possession of the land
