Jones of the County of Southampton of the second part witnesseth that whereas the said Edwin Jones and Martha his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty dollars in hand paid by the said William A. Jones the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged which bargain and sale conveyance and assignment and by these presents doth bargain sell convey and assign unto the said William A. Jones his heirs and assigns a certain Tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows on the North by the lands of John Thomas on the East by the lands of Joseph T. Clark on the South by the lands of the said Jones and on the West by the lands of John Thomas and Mary Thorne and bounded by the run of the Atlantic tract containing by a late survey three hundred and fifty nine acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the said bargain and premises with all and singular the appurtenances unto the only proper use and behoof of him the said William A. Jones his heirs and assigns and the said Edwin Jones and Martha his wife do for themselves their heirs and assigns warrant and defend the right and title of said land against the claims or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever In Testimony whereof we have hereunto set our hands and affixed our seals the day and date first written
