and James Haines all of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the third part
to have the said John Hart is jointly indebted to the said William and J. C. Haines
for becoming security to a note issued to Murray and Co. for the sum of one
hundred and eighty three dollars and 77 cents bearing date 14th day of April 1833.
also for being security to a note issued to Samuel Culbert for two hundred dollars
with interest bearing date about 25th day of December 1832 and also indebted to the
said James Haines on an unsettled account the amount not recollecting which debt
with interest of any the said Hart is willing and desirous to secure it on his Indenture
Notwithstanding that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further considera-
tion of One dollar lawful money of Virginia to the said Hart in hand paid by the said
H. P. Smith at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged by the said John Hart, Hart given granted sold aliened off
released and confirmed with these presents do give grant bargain sell alien off
release and confirm to the said H. P. Smith his heirs and assigns forever the following
negro to wit a man named Moman Savina boy Franks boy Amulek and boy Peter
together with the future increase of the said Moman Savina. To have and to hold the
above mentioned property to have and to hold the aforesaid slaves with the future increase
of the female aforesaid unto the said H. P. Smith his heirs Executors administrators and
assigns forever and the said John Hart do deliver his heirs Executors administrators and
assigns forever. To have and to hold the said Moman Savina boy Franks boy Amulek and boy Peter
his heirs and assigns forever in manner and form following to wit that the said Hart
his heirs &c. the aforesaid slaves and the future increase of the female slave of female to
the said H. P. Smith his heirs assigns &c. against all persons whatever that do or will
claim and forever defend by these presents upon these terms to wit that if the said
H. P. Smith his heirs &c. shall permit the said John Hart to remain in custody
praisable possession of the aforesaid slaves with the future increase of the female and take
the profits thereof to his own use without default to make in any of the terms of
above specified for which William and J. C. Haines or are bound as their security
then upon this further time that the said H. P. Smith or his legal representatives
shall and will so soon after the happening of such default as he may think proper
or the said William and J. C. Haines or their heirs &c. shall request sell the said
slaves and the future increase of the female said part of the above slaves at the
public or his representatives hereby authorized to act shall think proper for the
purpose and these things proper to sell to the highest bidder for ready money
at public auction after having fixed the time and place at his own discretion

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
