Burges to stand seized and possessed of the herein granted premises on the Trust as aforesaid and for the purposes as expressed above and covenants and agrees to execute the will and intention of the Grantor and faithfully to execute the Trust hereby imposed according to the tenor and effect hereof and further more covenants that in the event of a release being once of any that he will within the next year in it according to the true intention and meaning of this Conveyance execute the same to him that is to say to the said Burges or to the said Louisa or their issue in full discharge of the parties hereto have set their hands and seals this day and year first above written

I hereby certify that I release to my brother Peter Book all right title claim or demand whatever of any kind or nature that I have hold or have made to the three negro Slaves which my said brother owes in the division of our father's Estate for Miller Shepney and Arney and for which I have taken a Deed from my said brother which is of record in the Clerk's Office of the County of Southampton and I hereby certify that my only intention in taking the Deed from him for the negroes aforesaid was to prevent his making away with and alienating them thinking him incompetent to manage his estate given under my bond and Seal this 3^d of April 1833.
