

This Indenture made and entered into this 18th day of January in the year of our Lord one
 Thousand Eight hundred and thirty three Between John Griggard and Sally, his wife of the
 County of Sussex and State of Virginia James Harris of the County and State aforesaid Anne
 Harris and Polly his wife of the County of Southampton and State aforesaid Polly Harris
 of the County and State aforesaid and Lewis Harris of the County of Southampton and State
 of North Carolina of the first part and Joel Harris of the County of Southampton and State
 Virginia of the second part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum
 of three hundred and eighty dollars of lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid
 by the said Joel Harris the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given grants
 bargains and sold and by these presents do give grants bargain and sell unto said Joel
 Harris his heirs and assigns all the right title claim and interest which we have of in
 and to a certain tract or piece of ~~water~~ Land now belonging to Lucy Harris widow
 of Joel Harris dec^d which said land was allotted her as her dower. Situated lying and
 being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and on the South side of
 the three creeks containing by estimation when all added to the said Lucy Harris
 Ninety five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows Vizt by the lands
 of the said Joel Harris which was two thirds of the said tract of land which the said
 Joel Harris dec^d seized and possessed Major Humphrey Drury, Winifred Drury
 Hewitt Drury and David Westbrooks Stephen plantation To have and to hold
 the said land and premises together with all the appurtenances therunto belon-
 ging in any wise appertaining unto the only proper use and behoof of him the said
 Joel Harris and the said John Griggard and Sally his wife James Harris Anne
 Harris and Polly his wife Polly Harris and Lewis Harris do her heirs heirs
 &c. Covenant and agreed to and with the said Joel Harris his heirs and assigns before
 the making and delivery of these presents to warrant and defend at the death of the
 said Lucy Harris all the right title and interest which we have of in and to the
 aforesaid tract or parcel of land. In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our
