

Grizzard & This Indenture made and entered into this 15 day of January in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and thirty three Between John Grizzard and Sally his wife of the
 County of Surry and State of Virginia James Harris of the County and State aforesaid and
 Harris and Polly his wife of the County of Southampton and State aforesaid Polly Harris
 of the County and State aforesaid and Lewis Harris of the County of Southampton and State
 of Carolina of the first part and Joel Harris of the County of Southampton and State
 of Virginia of the second part. Witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum
 of One hundred and Eighty dollars of lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid
 by the said Joel Harris the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto said Joel
 Harris his heirs and assigns all the right title claim and interest which we have of
 and to a certain tract or parcel of land lying and belonging to Lucy Harris widow
 of Joel Harris dec^d which said land was allotted her after her husband situated lying and
 being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and on the south side of
 the three creeks containing by estimation when alloted to the said Lucy Harris
 thirty five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows West by the lands
 of the said Joel Harris which was two thirds of the said tract of land which the said
 Joel Harris left Lucy and prepared Major Humphrey Drury Wm. Fredr.
 Austin Drew and David Westbrook's Stephen plantation To have and to hold
 the said land and premises together with all the appurtenances therunto belong-
 ing or in any wise appertaining unto the only proper and sole of him the said
 Joel Harris and the said John Grizzard and Sally his wife James Harris Howell
 Harris and Polly his wife Polly Harris and Lewis Harris do further do witness
 & covenant and agree do and will the said Joel Harris his heirs and assigns before
 the sealing and delivery of these presents to warrant and defend at the date of the
 said Lucy Harris all the right title and interest which we have of and to the
 aforesaid tract or parcel of land. In witness whereof have hereunto set our
 hand and seals this day of January in our first aera written.
