This Indenture made and entered into this the first day of March English 1833
 and thirty three Between Thomas Jones of the first part and Bennett Whitfield the
 Trustee of the Second part and Henry Jones of the third part all of the County of South-
 ampton and State of Virginia Whereas the said Thomas Jones stands jointly
 indebted to the said Henry Jones by bond bearing date with these presents in the
 sum of twenty Eight and seventy four cents due the first day of November next ensuing
 and unto said Henry Jones by bond bearing date the 2nd day of January 1833 due
 the 1st day of December next ensuing which bond the said Henry Jones is bound as
 security for said Jones which debts with the legal interest thereon accruing the
 said Thomas Jones is willing and desirous to secure more than his signature Whith-
 er that for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia
 to the said Thomas Jones in hand paid by the said Bennett Whitfield the receipt whereof he
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he
 acknowledges he the said Thomas Jones hath given granted bargained sold
 alien conveyed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bar-
 gain sell alien convey release and confirm to the said Bennett Whitfield
 his heirs and assigns forever the following personal property to wit One sound
 horse four head of cows and three increase four head of hog and three increase
 three feather beds and furniture together with all the right title and interest
 of the said Thomas Jones in and to the above mentioned property hereby granted
 or intended to be hereby granted To have and to hold the said hereby granted
 or intended to be hereby granted personal property as above mentioned unto the
 said Bennett Whitfield the Trustee his heirs Executors administrators and
 assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Bennett Whitfield
 his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Thomas Jones
 his heirs Executors and assigns forever and the said Thomas Jones for himself his
 heirs Executors and assigns forever doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said
 Bennett Whitfield his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever that the said
 property hereby conveyed unto the said Bennett Whitfield his heirs Executors administrators
 and assigns against all persons who shall or will want and defend by these presents
 from time to time nevertheless that the said Bennett Whitfield his heirs Executors
 and assigns shall remain in quiet possession of the said property hereby conveyed and
 default be made in the payment of the said sum or sum of fifty Dollars and
 seventy four cents either in the whole or in part and then when the said
