That Indenture made this day of _____ Beyond between Stephen Gray and Marcellina
wifes of the one part of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and Henry Kendrick of the
County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Stephen Gray and Marcellina
his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars to them or him paid
by the said Henry Kendrick at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain
and sell unto the said Henry Kendrick his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of
land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and in the Parish of
Saint Lukes Containing One hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to
wit beginning at a post oak in Henry Kendrick's line thence near an East Corner to a post oak
in Nathaniel Nicholls's line thence along said Nicholls's line to a point a Corner in said Nicholls's
line thence near an East Corner of marked Trees to James Mills ^{beginning} thence up the said Mills
to a gum a Corner in said Kendrick's line thence near a West Corner to a red oak in said Kendrick's
line thence near a South Corner along said Kendrick's line to a post oak the beginning together
with all houses out houses outhouses and other buildings in any wise appertaining or thence to belong
To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land premises with its appurtenances
thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Henry Kendrick and his heirs
forever and the said Stephen Gray and his wife Marcellina do for them their heirs heirs
heirs and assigns give warrant and defend the lawful claim or claims of the said tract
aforesaid of land or any part thereof against all and every person or persons who shall
claim the same who of the said Stephen Gray and Marcellina his wife have heretofore set their
hands and affixed their seals this day and date above written
